Basic Hints for Memorization

Psalm 119:11 (Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee.)

Not only learn the scripture but the location of the scripture

Read it, say it, write it, visualize it and practice it.

First read it several times

Second write it several times

Third write it on index cards

Fourth write it on sticky notes and place in strategic places

Fifth try to visualize what you are reading, writing and saying

Sixth, practice, practice and then practice some more

Seventh remember the Bible is your only weapon against the enemy

I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.

And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.

And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:
